

## Probate Notes for October 31, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE: Estate of Saulnier**  
**Case No. CV PB 16-160**

The Court notes the following deficiency: *Notice of Petition to Administer Estate* was not properly published for the October 31, 2016 hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.) The *Proof of Publication* filed on October 18, 2016 states that a hearing on the petition was scheduled for October 18, 2016, rather than October 31, 2016.

**CASE: Estate of Sharp**  
**Case No. CV PB 14-97**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

**CASE: In re the Matter of the Brockhoff Family Trust**  
**Case No. CV P2 06-225**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on the seventh account and report by trustee, as ordered by the Court on August 29, 2016.
