

Probate Notes for October 4, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Cello
Case No. CV PC 16-95

The Court notes the following deficiency: An acknowledgment of receipt of the *Duties of Conservator and Acknowledgement of Receipt of Handbook* form has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1834; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1051.)

The Court Investigator's report indicates petitioners intended to file a petition for Appointment of Limited Conservator of the person and estate. Additionally, ALTA Regional Center recommends a limited conservatorship of the person and that only certain powers be granted. Therefore, the parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** to discuss whether a petition for limited conservatorship will be filed.

CASE: Estate of Salzillo
Case No. CV PB 15-22

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of executor, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the executor and attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Stout
Case No. CV PB 16-67

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to confirm assets to trust. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.)
