

Probate Notes for October 6, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Hess
Case No. CV PC 13-125

The Court notes the following deficiency: The property on hand at the end of the first accounting period was \$763.63 held in River City Bank account ending 2815. However, petitioner states that the property on hand at the beginning of the second accounting period is \$3.69 held in River City Bank account ending 2815 and an oil lease in Barton County Kansas valued at \$17,280.00.

CASE: Estate of Bach
Case No. CV PB 16-43

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner fails to provide a detailed schedule of the losses on the sale of the real property as required to support the request for attorneys' fees. (Cal. Rules of Court, rules 7.705(b), 7.550(b)(6).)

CASE: Estate of Tillman
Case No. CV PB 16-142

It is recommended to grant the petition for letters of administration, and for full authority under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Estate of Yin
Case No. CV PB 14-199

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of personal representative, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the personal representative and attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
