

Probate Notes for November 16, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Davidson
Case No. CV PB 01-137

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Taylor
Case No. CV PC 15-149

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on October 24, 2016.

CASE: Estate of Johnson
Case No. CV PB 16-64

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of executor, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the executor's attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: In re Matter of the Adela N. Alonso Revocable Trust
Case No. P2 16-166

If a declination to serve as successor trustee is filed by Ernest Alonso, II, it is recommended to approve the unopposed verified petition of Bryan Alonso to remove Ernest Alonso as trustee of the Adela N. Alonso Revocable Trust. (Prob. Code, § 15642, 17200, 16000 et seq.)
