

## Probate Notes for November 9, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Bartal**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-158**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the hearing as ordered by the Court on September 26, 2016.

**CASE:            Estate of Taylor**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-236**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for the executor's for ordinary services, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.) Petitioners are directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
