

## Probate Notes for December 1, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Contreras**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-111**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The account and report is not verified as required. (Prob. Code, § 1021, subd. (b)(1); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.103(b).
2. Petitioners failed to provide a summary of account using the mandatory Judicial Council Form GC-400SUM. (Prob. Code, §§ 1060 et seq, 2620, Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.575.)
3. Proof that the *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council Form GC-020) has been served on the required parties has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1460, subd. (b).)

**CASE:            Estate of Delatorre**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-38**

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner fails to state whether notice was given or was required under Probate Code section 9201.
