

Probate Notes for February 17, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m. unless stated otherwise.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Reiff

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: In re the Matter of the Ammons Trust
Case No. CV P2 15-217

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on grant Tracy Ammons's petition as ordered by the Court on January 13, 2016.
