

## Probate Notes for February 18, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE: Estate of Stinnett  
Case No. CV PB 15-241**

The Court notes the following deficiencies with Kimberly LaDon Thompson's petition for probate of will and for letters testamentary:

1. The original will has not been lodged with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.)
2. Petitioner failed to file written bond waivers from each heir at law as alleged in paragraph 3(d) of the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8481.)
3. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

There are no deficiencies with William Douglas Thompson's petition for probate of will and letters testamentary.

**CASE: In the Matter of the Gilmete Family Trust  
Case No. CV P2 16-02**

Petitioner has failed to file proof the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition were served on the required parties by January 28, 2016, as ordered by the Court on January 11, 2016.
