

Probate Notes for February 22, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Maxwell
Case No. CV PC 14-208

It is recommended to grant the petition for termination of conservatorship. (Prob. Code, § 1861 et seq.; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1052(a).)

CASE: Estate of Bauer
Case No. CV P2 15-245

It is recommended to grant Morgan Bauer's unopposed verified petition to compel the delivery and transfer of cash account held by Bank of America to the successor in interest. (Prob. Code, § 13100 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
