

Probate Notes for February 9, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Jones
Case No. CV PC 87-18730

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The petition fails to include Attachment 1c with the petition stating the reasons a bond is not required. (Petition, ¶ 1(c)(1).)
2. The petition does not state whether the conservatee will attend the hearing. (Petition, ¶¶ 8(a), 8(e).) The portions of paragraph 8 that petitioner has filled out apply to the initial appointment of conservators only and not for successor conservators.

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Tuesday, March 8, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: Estate of Guerra
Case No. CV PB 15-145

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner has failed to provide notice of the hearing as ordered by the Court on February 1, 2016. (Prob. Code, ¶ 1200 et seq.)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on February 1, 2016.
