

Probate Notes for March 22, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Klotz
Case No. CV PB 00-153

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, August 27, 2015.

It is recommended to approve the verified second and final account and report of the co-conservators and to grant the petition for discharge. (Prob. Code, § 2620 et seq.) Petitioners are directed to submit a proposed order prior to the hearing.

CASE: Estate of Nixon
Case No. CV PB 15-193

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-147).
2. Proof of publication must be filed prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 8120 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Parren
