

Probate Notes for March 24, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Alger

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Thursday, April 21, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: Conservatorship of Jojo
Case No. CV PC 10-44

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on May 1, 2015.

Carolyn M. Young's third and final account and report has been filed and is set to be heard on April 25, 2016. Therefore, the biennial review hearing is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**.
