

Probate Notes for March 28, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Barth
Case No. CV PC 14-192

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of Jordanne Young as probate conservator of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a new proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Bugreyev
Case No. CV PC 16-19

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Monday, April 25, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report and for receipt of Alta California Regional Center's report and recommendations.

CASE: Conservatorship of Poe
Case No. CV PC 16-13

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Wednesday, March 30, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11.

CASE: In Re the JoAnn M. Mahan Trust
