

Probate Notes for March 4, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Berry
Case No. CV PC 10-32

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and fifth verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Felix
Case No. CV PC 15-212

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Michael Campos and Diana Fallbeck's petition for appointment of conservator as ordered by the Court on February 8, 2016.

CASE: Conservatorship of Kasmire
Case No. CV PC 11-132

The conservatorship terminated by order of the Court on February 8, 2013.

It is recommended to approve the verified second and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Martinez
Case No. CV PC 14-59

It is recommended to grant the petition to place conservatee in a secured perimeter facility and to consent to the administration of dementia medication. (Prob. Code, §§ 2356.5, 2357.)

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, April 1, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Turbull

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, December 22, 2014.

It is recommended to approve the verified third and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.)
