

Probate Notes for April 11, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Estate of Bueler
Case No. CV PB 10-112

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for ordinary and extraordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Estate of Pereira
Case No. CV PB 14-136

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition to authorize and approve the settlement agreement. (Prob. Code, § 9832, subd. (a).)

It is recommended to approve the personal representative's status report. (Prob. Code, § 12201, subd. (c)(1).)
