

Probate Notes for April 12, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Jones
Case No. CV PC 87-18730

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of successor probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 2680 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Loney
Case No. CV PB 15-159

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for ordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: In re the Jen Toy Wong Trust
Case No. CV P2 15-778

It is recommended to **DENY** petitioner Toy Eng's first amended petition for financial elder abuse, conversion, breach of trust, and removal of trustee. The first amended petition is not properly verified. (Code Civ. Proc., § 446; Prob. Code, § 1021.)
