

## Probate Notes for April 27, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE: Estate of Holton  
Case No. CV PB 16-35**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof that the notice of hearing has been served on Steven Holton has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, §§ 8100, 8110.)
2. The *Duties and Liabilities of Personal Representative* form must be filed with the Court (Judicial Council of California Form DE-147).

**CASE: Estate of Little  
Case No. CV P2 16-47**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. A typed copy of the handwritten will was not attached to the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8002, subd. (b)(1); Petition, ¶ 4c.)
2. Petitioner fails to provide evidence that she is entitled to a one-third interest in the Bernice A. Little Revocable Trust Agreement dated November 24, 1998.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Love  
Case No. CV PC 12-118**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)
