

Probate Notes for April 6, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Chavez
Case No. CV PC 16-23

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Hulse
Case No. CV PB 83-17534

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Parren
Case No. CV PB 14-143

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition for an order establishing a special needs trust for Juliene Parren and that the order for final distribution of the estate be amended as requested. (Prob. Code, §§ 2580, subd. (b)(5), 3602, subd. (d); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.903.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the hearing that complies with Probate Code section 3604(d) and California Rule of Court 7.903(c).
