

Probate Notes for May 2, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Estate of Jonasen
Case No. CV PB 16-38

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner failed to include her relationship to decedent in paragraph 8 of the petition. Petitioner is also directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: Estate of Krug
Case No. CV PB 13-209

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of personal representatives, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the personal representatives and attorney for ordinary and extraordinary services, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: Timm v. Timm
Case No. CV P2 16-37
