

Probate Notes for May 4, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

**CASE: Estate of Little
Case No. CV P2 16-47**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. A typed copy of the handwritten will was not attached to the petition. (Prob. Code, § 8002, subd. (b)(1); Petition, ¶ 4c.)
2. A proof of service for the declaration of Sean H. Colon filed on April 25, 2016, must be filed with the Court.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Nakagiri
Case No. CV PC 09-138**

The Court notes the following deficiency: The conservator failed to file the required accounting as ordered by the Court on July 15, 2015. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**

**CASE: Estate of Poarch
Case No. CV PB 15-85**

The Court notes the following deficiency: Proof that Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. was served with the notice of hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, §§ 1220, 11000.) On August 3, 2015, Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. filed a request for special notice.
