

## Probate Notes for May 6, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Maggiolo

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

**CASE:            LPS Conservatorship of Hall  
                      Case No. CV PB 76-14514**

It is recommended to approve the verified eleventh account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

**CASE:            LPS Conservatorship of Serrato  
                      Case No. CV PB 00-112**

It is recommended to approve the verified sixteenth account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
