

Probate Notes for May 10, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Aguayo
Case No. CV PC 16-49

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, May 20, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11, for the appointment of legal counsel for the proposed conservatee as recommended in the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1470, 2356.5, subd. (f)(1).)

CASE: Estate of Clinton
Case No. CV PB 14-154

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting, for allowance of statutory compensation to the attorney for ordinary services, for authorization to withhold a reserve fund, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.) Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing that is consistent with the petition. The current order lodged with the Court requests that Court authorize petitioner to pay herself compensation in the amount of \$9,022.99. However, the verified amended petition filed on March 14, 2016, states that petitioner has elected to waive her statutory commission. (Amended Petition, ¶ 25.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Maxwell
Case No. CV PC 14-208

The conservator Janet D. Thatcher and/or her attorney are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR**. On February 22, 2016, the Court granted the petition to terminate the conservatorship. However, the Court ordered Ms. Thatcher to file an accounting within 60 days after entry of the Court's order. More than 60 days have passed and Ms. Thatcher has failed to file her final accounting.

**CASE: Estate of Tapia
Case No. CV PB 13-198**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution on waiver of accounting and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

**CASE: Estate of Vasquez
Case No. CV PB 16-34**

It is recommended to grant the petition for probate of will and letters testamentary and for authorization to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8200.)
