

Probate Notes for May 12, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

**CASE: Estate of Breckner
Case No. CV PB 16-51**

The Court notes the following deficiency: Paragraph 2d is incomplete. Petitioner fails to indicate whether she intends on obtaining a bond.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Smith
Case No. CV PC 16-57**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof that the notice of hearing has been served on the required parties has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1822.)
2. A Capacity Declaration (form GC-335) has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1881.)
3. An acknowledgment of receipt of the *Duties of Conservator and Acknowledgement of Receipt of Handbook* form has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1834; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1051.)

**CASE: Estate of Wadlin
Case No. CV PB 15-66**

The Court notes the following deficiency: A proof of service for the notice of hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 11000.) Additionally, petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
