

Probate Notes for May 13, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Plude
Case No. CV PC 09-35

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Bruce
Case No. CV PB 03-66

The conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on March 18, 2012.

It is recommended to approve the verified ninth account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for discharge of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Labarbera
Case No. LP SQ 13-21

The conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on October 24, 2014.

It is recommended to approve the verified second account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for discharge of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Medich
Case No. LP SQ 11-09

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on January 3, 2015.

It is recommended to approve the verified second account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for discharge of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
