

Probate Notes for May 20, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Aguayo
Case No. CV PC 16-49

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the appointment of legal counsel for the proposed conservatee and to discuss the possible appointment of the public guardian as conservator of the person based on the information provided in the court investigator's supplemental report. (Prob. Code, § 1470, 2356.5, subd. (f)(1).)

CASE: Conservatorship of Brewer
Case No. CV PB 07-56

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and fifth verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Mitchell
Case No. CV PC 13-74

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and second verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Foster
Case No. LP SQ 09-9

It is recommended to approve the verified seventh account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
