

Probate Notes for May 23, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

The petition for an order determining distribution rights is **CONTINUED** on the Court's own motion to June 23, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department Eleven, so that the Court may more thoroughly consider the petition.
