

## Probate Notes for May 27, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Anderson**  
**Case No. CV PB 90-19488**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and fourteenth verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Fraire**  
**Case No. CV PC 11-33**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and third verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Hamilton**  
**Case No. CV PC 12-229**

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on July 24, 2014.

The Court notes the following deficiency: The conservator has not filed a final account and report of the conservator. (Prob. Code, § 2620, subd. (b).) The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**
