

Amended Probate Notes for June 10, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

It is recommended to approve the verified second account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Lee
Case No. CV PB 06-192

It is recommended to approve the verified sixth and final account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for discharge of the LPS conservator of the person and estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Padilla
Case No. LP SQ 09-17

It is recommended to approve the verified seventh account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Woods
Case No. LP SQ 14-26

It is recommended to approve the verified second account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
