

Probate Notes for June 14, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Gleason
Case No. CV PC 10-116

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Erhardt
Case No. CV PB 15-156

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner fails to state whether notice was given or was required under Probate Code section 9201.

CASE: Estate of Farmer
Case No. CV P2 16-50

The Court notes the following deficiency: A proof of service for the "errata note regarding petition" filed by petitioner Lora L. Farmer on May 12, 2016, must be filed with the Court.

CASE: In re Matter of the Buchignani Trust
Case No. P2 16-55

It is recommended to approve the unopposed verified petition of Stacy Buchignani Gale and Brian Buchignani to remove Marty Buchignani as trustee of the Charlotte A Buchignani Trust. (Prob. Code, § 15642, 17200, 16000 et seq.)
