

Probate Notes for June 3, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Kelly
Case No. CV PC 15-61

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner's accounting is inconsistent with the inventory and appraisal forms filed on May 19, 2015 and November 17, 2015. The inventory and appraisals reflect the property on hand at the beginning of the account period to be \$60,435.19. However, petitioner's accounting states the property on hand at the beginning of the account period was \$30,435.19. Additionally, it appears conservatee's trailer was sold on October 7, 2015, for less than the appraised amount. The loss from this sale is not included in petitioner's accounting.
