

## Probate Notes for July 20, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Cartoscelli**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-58**

It is recommended to appoint legal counsel for the proposed limited conservatee. (Prob. Code, § 1471, subd. (c).)

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of limited conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Hoyt**  
**Case No. CV PC 12-139**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing on Charles Jensen's third account and report of conservator as ordered by the Court on June 28, 2016.

**CASE:            Estate of Shakir**  
**Case No. CV PB 15-83**

It is recommended to deny Uzma Khalil's amended petition for letters of administration. Ms. Khalil was appointed administrator of the estate on October 21, 2015.

It is recommended to deny Uzma Khalil's amended spousal property petition. The Court has already confirmed items to Ms. Khalil on October 21, 2015.
