

## Probate Notes for July 6, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Barnes, Jr.**  
**Case No. CV PC 12-200**

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Tuesday, July 26, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

**CASE: Conservatorship of Foster-Flippo**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-59**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

**CASE: Conservatorship of Nakagiri**  
**Case No. CV PC 09-138**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and fourth verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)

**CASE: Conservatorship of A. Zalunardo**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-46**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

- (1) Proof that the notice of hearing has been served on the Office of the Veterans Administration has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1822, subd. (d).)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing to address whether Yolo County is the appropriate forum in light of the proposed conservatee and one of the proposed conservators living in Oregon. (Prob. Code, § 1996.)

The Court declines to consider Ann Ellis's motions: 1) authorizing sale of the residence, 2) for conservator compensation, and 3) for reimbursement of temporary conservator for attorney's fees until a determination has been made whether Yolo County is the appropriate forum.

**CASE:           Conservatorship of L. Zalunardo**  
**Case No. CV PC 16-45**

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing to address whether Yolo County is the appropriate forum in light of the proposed conservatee and one of the proposed conservators living in Oregon. (Prob. Code, § 1996.)

The Court declines to consider Ann Ellis's motions: 1) authorizing sale of the residence, 2) for conservator compensation, and 3) for reimbursement of temporary conservator for attorney's fees until a determination has been made whether Yolo County is the appropriate forum.

**CASE:           Conservatorship of Zavala**  
**Case No. CV PC 15-77**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

**CASE:           Estate of Emerick**  
**Case No. CV PB 16-97**

It is recommended to grant the petition for probate of will and letters testamentary and for authorization to administer the estate under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8200.)
