

Probate Notes for July 7, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Welch
Case No. CV PC 16-12

The Court notes that petitioner has failed to file an amended petition as ordered by the Court on June 9, 2016.

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on June 9, 2016.

CASE: Estate of Crutcher
Case No. CV P2 16-82

It is recommended to grant the petition to determine succession to real property. (Prob. Code, § 13150 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Khamashta
Case No. CV PB 15-116

It is recommended to approve the first and final account and report of executor, and to grant the petition for allowance of statutory compensation to the executor and attorney for ordinary services, allowance of compensation for extraordinary services, and for final distribution and settlement of the estate. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
