

Probate Notes for August 19, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Borchers
Case No. CV PC 16-61

The parties are DIRECTED TO APPEAR for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on July 29, 2016.

CASE: Conservatorship of Cardoza
Case No. CV PC 16-94

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of limited conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Cartoscelli
Case No. CV PC 16-58

The Court notes the following deficiencies with Conrad and Carroll Getter's petition for appointment of probate conservator:

1. Petitioners have failed to file a *Capacity Declaration* (form GC-335) with the Court. (Prob. Code, §§ 1881, 1890.)
2. An acknowledgment of receipt of the *Duties of Conservator and Acknowledgement of Receipt of Handbook* form has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1834; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1051.)
3. A confidential written report of the regional center's findings and recommendations regarding Conrad and Carroll Getter's appointment as conservators must be filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1827.5.) The regional center's report must also be mailed, at least five days prior to the hearing, to the proposed conservatee and the petitioner, or attorney of the petitioner. (*Ibid.*)

On the Court's own motion the matter is **CONTINUED** to Friday, September 16, 2016, in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: Conservatorship of Taylor
Case No. CV PC 99-173

The parties are DIRECTED TO APPEAR for the continued hearing as ordered by the Court on July 15, 2016.

CASE: Conservatorship of Thompson
Case No. CV PC 15-53

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report and first verified account and report of conservator. (Prob. Code, §§ 1850 et seq., 2620, 1060.)
