

Probate Notes for August 26, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Franklin
Case No. CV PC 11-94

Due to the death of the conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, January 14, 2015.

It is recommended to approve the verified third and final account and report of the conservator and to grant the petition for discharge upon the filing of a final declaration with the Court showing that the remaining estate assets, if any, have been properly delivered. (Prob. Code, §§ 2467, 2620 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Chapman

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of conservator of the person and the estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Cruz
