

Probate Notes for August 30, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Orris
Case No. CV PC 13-141

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Wells
Case No. CV PC 11-199

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Estate of Salzillo
Case No. CV P2 15-22

If petitioner files proof that notice of the hearing was served as required, it is recommended the grant the petition. (Prob. Code, §§ 11000, 1211, 1220.)

CASE: Estate of Bowsbey
Case No. CV PB 76-14692

If petitioner files proof that notice of the hearing was served as required, it is recommended the grant the petition. (Prob. Code, §§ 17200, 17203, 1211.)

CASE: Estate of Zamora
Case No. CV PB 16-99

The Court has reviewed the objection filed by Amabelle Ocampo. To the extent Ms. Ocampo contests the right of Heather Jones to be appointed as personal representative, Ms. Ocampo has failed to file a petition which asserts the right of an alternative person to be appointed as personal representative as required. (Prob. Code, § 8004, subd. (a).)

**CASE: In the Matter of the DuBois Revocable Trust – Survivor’s Trust
Case No. CV PB 16-115**

Petitioner has failed to file proof the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition were served on First Northern Bank, Bank of America, or Wells Fargo Bank, who have possession of the property set forth in the petition. (Prob. Code, § 851.)
