

Probate Notes for September 12, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Sanchez
Case No. CV PC 16-126

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)
2. A Capacity Declaration (form GC-335) has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, §§ 1881, 1890.)
3. A *Confidential Supplemental Information* statement (form GC-312) has not been filed with the Court.

CASE: Conservatorship of Taylor
Case No. CV PC 15-149

On the Court's own motion, the matter is **CONTINUED** to Monday, October 10, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in Department 11 for completion of the court investigator's report.

CASE: Estate of Navarrette
Case No. CV PB 16-122

It is recommended to grant the petition for letters of administration, and for full authority under the Independent Administration of Estates Act. (Prob. Code, § 8000 et seq.)
