

## Probate Notes for September 13, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:           Estate of Chen**  
**Case No. CV PB 16-103**

The Court notes the following deficiency: Based on Paragraph 8 of the petition, it appears decedent's spouse resides in Taipei, Taiwan. Where any property will pass to a citizen of a foreign country, notice must be given to a recognized diplomatic or consular official of the foreign country maintaining an office in the United States. (Prob. Code, § 8113.) Petitioner must provide the required notice, or in the alternative, demonstrate that this requirement does not apply.
