

Probate Notes for September 16, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Cartoscelli
Case No. CV PC 16-58

The Court notes the following deficiencies with Conrad and Carroll Getter's petition for appointment of limited probate conservator:

1. Petitioners have failed to file a *Capacity Declaration* (form GC-335) with the Court. (Prob. Code, §§ 1881, 1890.)
2. An acknowledgment of receipt of the *Duties of Conservator and Acknowledgement of Receipt of Handbook* form has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1834; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1051.)

There are no deficiencies with Daniel and Cristin Wilson's petition for appointment of limited probate conservator.

Based on the recommendations of the ALTA Regional Center, it is recommended to deny Conrad and Carroll Getter's petition and to grant Daniel and Cristin Wilson's petition. Daniel and Cristin Wilson are directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Bates
Case No. LP SQ 11-49

It is recommended to approve the verified fifth account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

CASE: LPS Conservatorship of Johnson
Case No. LP SQ 16-38

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of conservator of the person and the estate. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)
