

Probate Notes for September 20, 2016

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please note: The Yolo Superior Court is now located at 1000 Main Street, in Woodland. The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eleven at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Levine
Case No. CV PB 16-132

The Court notes the following deficiency: Proof that the citation and petition were served on the proposed conservatee at least 15 days before the hearing has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1824.)

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** to inform the Court of the proposed conservatee's current location.

CASE: Conservatorship of McCullough
Case No. CV PB 96-83

The parties are **DIRECTED TO APPEAR** for Mr. Del Campo's motion for attorney's fees and for the status conference regarding appointment of counsel, as ordered by the Court on August 25, 2016.

CASE: Estate of Whiteneck
Case No. CV PB 15-167

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner fails to state whether notice was given or was required to the Victim's Compensation and Government Claims Board. (Prob. Code, § 9202, subd. (b).)
2. Petitioner fails to state whether notice was given to the Franchise Tax Board. (Prob. Code, § 9202, subd. (c).)
3. Petitioner fails to provide a detailed schedule of the receipts and gains (losses) on the sale of the real property as required to support the request for attorneys' fees. (Cal. Rules of Court, rules 7.705(b), 7.550(b)(6).)
