

## Probate Notes for August 2, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Garrette**  
**Case No. CV PC 18-114**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Conservator failed to file an accounting as required. (Prob. Code, § 2620.)
2. Proof that *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council form GC-020) has been served on the required parties has not been filed with the Court. (Prob. Code, § 1460, subd. (b).)

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Kruger**  
**Case No. CV PC 14-10**

The Court notes that no documents have been filed since the last hearing. The following deficiency remains: Conservator has not filed a final accounting as required. (Prob. Code, § 2620, subd. (b); California Rules of Court, rule 7.1052, subd. (c).)

**CASE:            Conservatorship of Riesberg**  
**Case No. LP SQ 18-33**

It is recommended to approve the verified first account and report of conservator and to grant the petition for reappointment of conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
