

Probate Notes for August 6, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Davis
Case No. CV PC 12-131

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Lamp-Smith
Case No. CV PC 11-67

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for August 10, 2021.

CASE: Estate of Torres
Case No. CV PB 17-40

This matter will be heard in **Department Eight.**

It is recommended to grant the first and final report of administrator on waiver of account and petition for allowance of statutory compensation to administrator and attorney and for final distribution. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Westervelt
Case No. CV PC 11-7

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for August 9, 2021.
