

Probate Notes for August 8, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of McCullough
Case No. CV PB 96-83

Petitioner Carolyn M. Young's sixth account and report of conservator and petitions for approval of account and report, and for conservator's and attorney's fees is **DROPPED FROM CALENDAR**. The Court's January 11, 2018 order specified that an accounting was to be filed for the January 9, 2020 hearing. Petitioner does not indicate why an accounting was filed early.

CASE: Estate of Williams
Case No. CV PB 19-91

Petitioner Natividad Williams's petition for letters of administration has been withdrawn.

The Court notes the following deficiency with petitioner Betty Goodwin's petition for letters of administration: Petitioner failed to publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the city where the decedent resided at the time of death. (Prob. Code, § 8121, subd. (b).)
