

Probate Notes for August 9, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Aceves
Case No. LP SQ 17-30

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Crites
Case No. LP SQ 13-32

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)
2. *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council form GC-020) and a copy of the petition were not served on all required individuals at least 15 days prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 1822.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Dao
Case No. CV PC 14-74

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for August 13, 2021.

CASE: Conservatorship of DeLonge
Case No. CV PB 94-20787

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

2. *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council form GC-020) and a copy of the petition were not served on all required individuals at least 15 days prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 1822.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Gidcumb
Case No. CV PC 10-94

The Court notes the following deficiency: *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council form GC-020) was not served on all required individuals at least 15 days prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 1460.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Hague
Case No. CV PB 97-265

Due to the death of conservatee, the conservatorship of the person terminated, by operation of law, on December 19, 2018. (Prob. Code, § 1860; Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1052, subd. (b).)

However, the Court has not received conservator's final accounting as required, which conservator is directed to file on or before September 3, 2019. (Prob. Code, § 2620, subd. (b); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.1052, subd. (c).)

CASE: Conservatorship of Howard
Case No. CV PB 71-12608

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Hunt
Case No. CV PC 16-25

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for August 13, 2021.

CASE: Conservatorship of Onstott
Case No. LP SQ 10-46

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)
2. *Notice of Hearing* (Judicial Council form GC-020) and a copy of the petition were not served on all required individuals at least 15 days prior to the hearing. (Prob. Code, § 1822.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Taylor
