

## Probate Notes for August 14, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

### **The following probate matters will be heard in Department Eight.**

**CASE:           Matter of Krale**  
**Case No. CV P2 19-154**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. A copy of decedent's will was not attached to the petition. (Prob. Code, § 13152, subd. (c).)
2. An inventory and appraisal has not been filed with the Court as required. (Prob. Code, § 13152, subd. (b); Petition, ¶ 8.)
3. Petitioners do not indicate whether no proceeding is being or has been conduct in this state for administration of decedent's estate, or decedent's personal representative has consented in writing to use of the procedure provided by Probate Code section 13150 et seq. (Prob. Code, § 13152, subd. (a)(5); Petition, ¶ 6.)
4. Attachment 11 does not contain the legal description of decedent's real property. (Prob. Code, § 13152, subd. (a)(3); Petition, ¶ 11.)
5. Petitioners fail to include Attachment 14 with the petition as required. (Prob. Code, § 13152, subd. (a)(7); Petition, ¶ 14.)

### **The following probate matters will be heard in Department Twelve.**

**CASE:           Estate of Haider**  
**Case No. CV PB 18-207**

It is recommended to grant the petition for final distribution, waiver of accounting, and for allowance of statutory fees to personal representative and attorney for personal representative. (Prob. Code, § 11600 et seq.)
