

Probate Notes for August 15, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

CASE: Conservatorship of Cole
Case No. CV PC 19-77

The proposed conservatee is **DIRECTED TO APPEAR.**

It is recommended to appoint legal counsel for the proposed conservatee. (Prob. Code, § 1471, subd. (b).)

It is recommended to deny petitioner Donald Cole's petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

It is recommended to deny petitioner Stephen Cole's petition for appointment of probate conservator of the person and estate. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

It is recommended to order reimbursement for the court investigator's report in the amount of \$450.

CASE: Conservatorship of McAfee
Case No. CV PC 14-101

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for August 16, 2021.
