

Probate Notes for August 16, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: The following probate matters will be heard in **Department Twelve at 9:00 a.m.**

CASE: Conservatorship of Chapman
Case No. LP SQ 16-36

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Green
Case No. CV PC 19-159

It is recommended to appoint legal counsel for the proposed limited conservatee. (Prob. Code, § 1471, subd. (c).)

It is recommended to grant the petition for appointment of limited conservator of the person. (Prob. Code, § 1820 et seq.)

It is recommended to set an annual review for August 21, 2020.

CASE: Conservatorship of Kuschmann
Case No. CV PC 16-91

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner failed to provide the summary of account using the mandatory Judicial Council form GC-400(SUM). (Prob. Code, §§ 1061, 2620, subd. (a); Cal. Rules of Court, rule 7.101, subd. (a).)

CASE: Matter of Wallace
Case No. LP SQ 17-25

The Court notes the following deficiency: Petitioner did not serve the petition for reappointment on the person in charge of conservatee's facility at least 30 days before the automatic termination date. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5361.)

CASE: Conservatorship of Wilcox
Case No. LP SQ 18-37

It is recommended to approve the verified first and final account and report of the conservator. (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5350 et seq.)

Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
