

Probate Notes for August 20, 2019

Probate notes are a recommendation as to the outcome of the petition. Unlike tentative rulings, they do not automatically become adopted as the order of the court. Unless an appearance at the hearing is otherwise required by law, if petitioner submits a proposed order prior to the hearing and the recommendation is to grant the petition, no appearance is necessary. If you are scheduled to appear and there is no probate note issued in your case, you should appear as scheduled. If you wish to continue a matter, you must contact the civil division at (530) 406-6704, at least two (2) court days before your hearing.

Please Note: Unless otherwise noted, the following probate matters will be heard in **Department Eight at 9:00 a.m.**

**CASE: Estate of Mamea
Case No. CV PB 19-150**

The Court notes the following deficiencies:

1. The petition does not include the names, ages, addresses, and relationships to decedent of all persons mentioned in decedent's will. (Petition, ¶ 8.)
2. Petitioner is directed to file a copy of the Tai and Stacey Mamea Living Trust, dated July 26, 2007, with the Court, so that it may determine if notice has been provided to all required individuals. (Prob. Code., § 1208, subd. (b).)

**CASE: Conservatorship of Nunes
Case No. CV PC 18-169**

This matter will be heard in **Department Twelve.**

It is recommended to approve the court investigator's report. (Prob. Code, § 1850 et seq.)

It is recommended to set a biennial review for August 20, 2021.

**CASE: Matter of Sambucetti Trust
Case No. CV P2 19-58**

It is recommended to grant the unopposed petition for order confirming trust assets. (Prob. Code, § 850 et seq; *Estate of Heggstad* (1993) 16 Cal.App.4th 943.)

Petitioner is directed to submit a proposed order prior to the date of the hearing.
