The parties' requests for judicial notice are **GRANTED**. (Evid. Code, § 452, subs (d), (h).)

Plaintiff Anthony Virk's motion to confirm the appraisers' valuations and issue the proposed alternative decree is **GRANTED**. (Corp. Code, §§ 2000, 17707.03.) Defendant Blaine Juchau fails to establish that the Court has authority to delay, for more than six months, the deadline for defendant to purchase plaintiff's shares, or alternatively, to wind up and dissolve the subject entities. (Corp. Code, §§ 2000, subd. (c), 17707.03, subd. (c)(3); *Go v. Pacific Health Services, Inc.* (2009) 179 Cal.App.4th 522; *Cotton v. Expo Power System, Inc.* (2009) 170 Cal. App. 4th 1371, 1379-1380.)

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
