Plaintiffs Marcelino Marquez, Rigoberto Hernandez, Ignacio Hernandez, and Salvador Duenas's request for judicial notice is **GRANTED**. (Evid. Code, §452, subd. (d).)

Plaintiffs' unopposed motion for terminating, issue, evidentiary, and monetary sanctions is **GRANTED IN PART**. Monetary sanctions are **GRANTED** against defendant Abel V. Arreola in the amount of \$1,862.00. (Code Civ. Proc., §§ 2023.010, 2023.030, subd. (a); Decl. of Mark A. Pruner, ¶ 15.) Sanctions are not granted for time not yet incurred. Defendant shall pay the monetary sanctions to plaintiff by July 19, 2016. Further, in accordance with the Court's prior order dated March 24, 2016, defendant shall serve verified answers to plaintiffs' form interrogatories and requests for production of documents, together with all responsive documents, without objections, by July 19, 2016. Defendant's failure to comply with this Court's order may constitute a ground for imposing terminating sanctions.

If no hearing is requested, this tentative ruling is effective immediately. No formal order pursuant to California Rule of Court 3.1312, or further notice is required.
